Re: 2008-2009 State General Revenue Contracts

The purpose of this memo is to inform you that as a result of an expected decrease in state-wide tax revenue collections, the Department of Elder Affairs is holding back 4% of all State of Florida General Revenue funded programs, including ADI, CCE, HCE, LSP and Contracted Services for FY 2008-2009. The Alliance will amend these contracts accordingly. A hold back, as opposed to a budget cut, can be rescinded if, and when, funding becomes available.

In order to provide you with information regarding legislative activities affecting Alliance for Aging funded programs, we have asked Mr. Fausto Gomez of the firm Gomez Barker & Associates to make a presentation to all service providers participating in any of the State General Revenue Funded programs.

The presentation will be held on Thursday, July 10 at 2 PM at the City of South Miami-City Hall Commission Chambers located at 6130 Sunset Drive (SW 72 Street), Miami, Florida 33143
